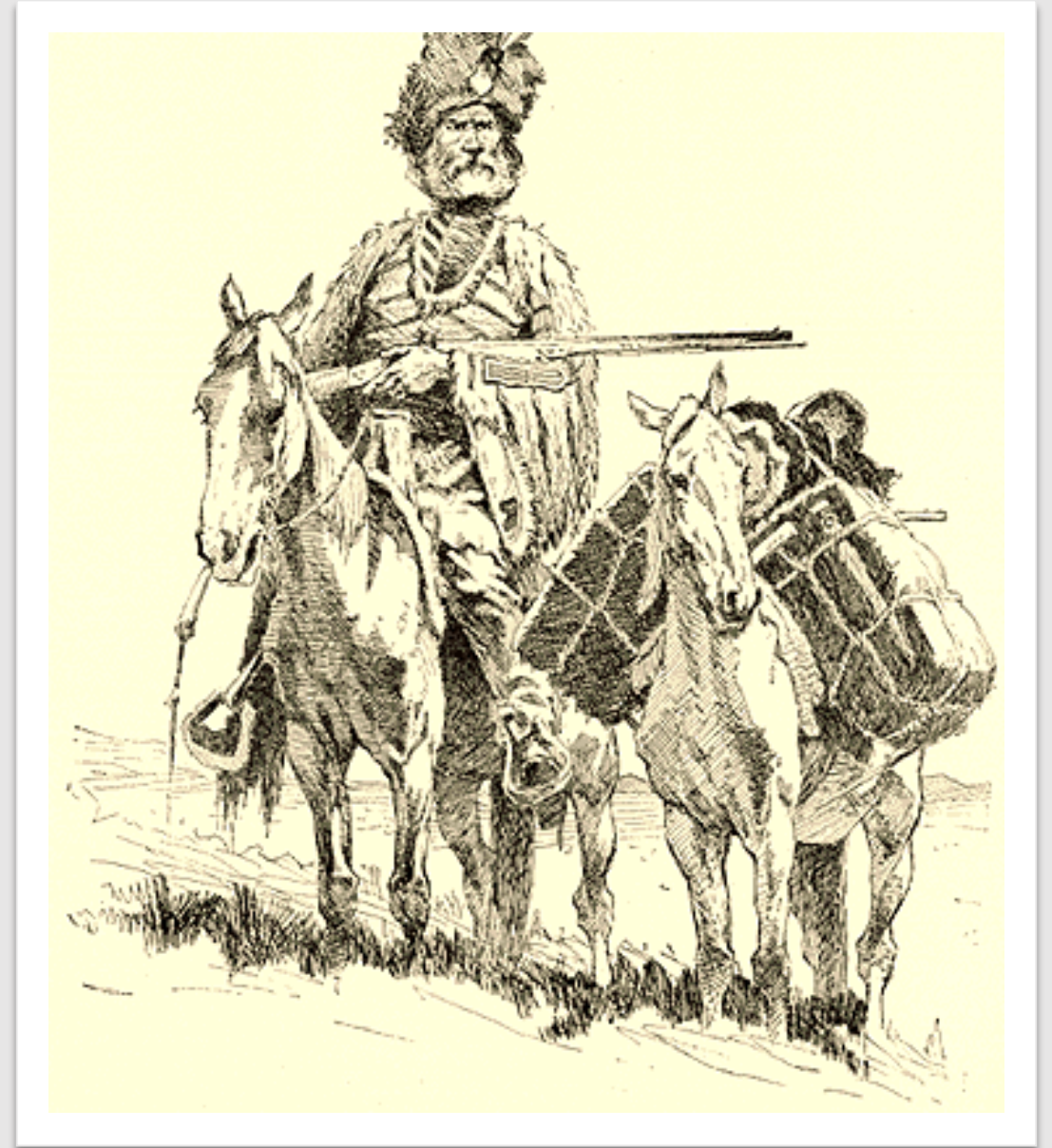


English



French Colonial Style

- Establishment of fur trade with natives
 - Mostly beaver, buffalo
 - Also traded for their meat (pemmican)

- Fur trade so large, wars were started amongst natives for control of beaver
- French allow natives to find, capture, and transport furs to French trading posts for trade
- Most French in Americas were young men who traded with natives and worked for...

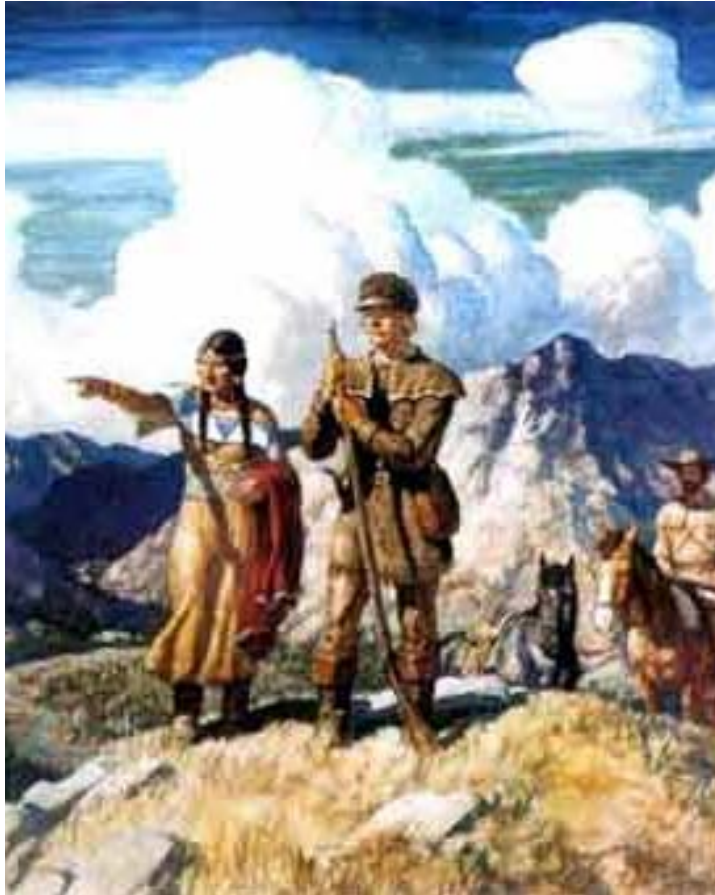




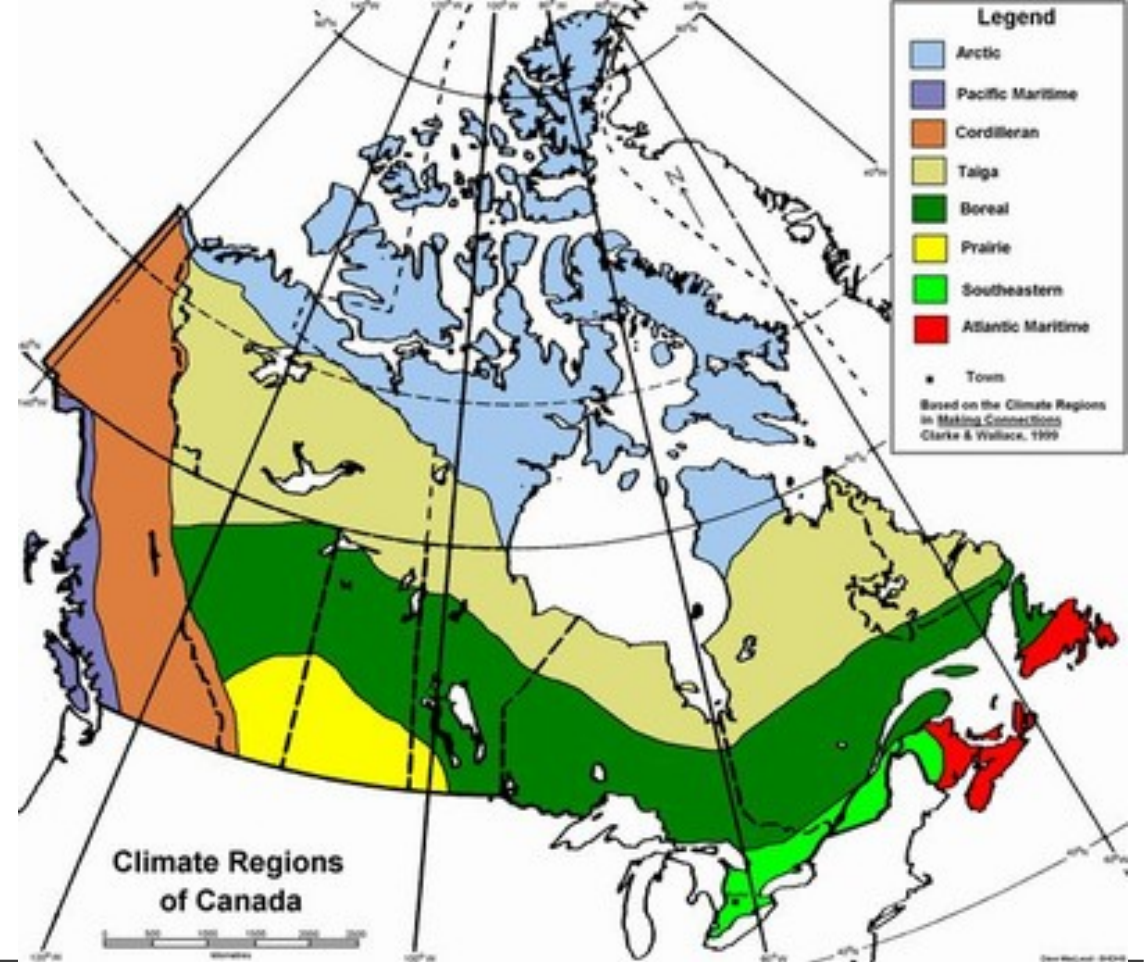
HUDSON'S BAY

Fur trader lifestyle



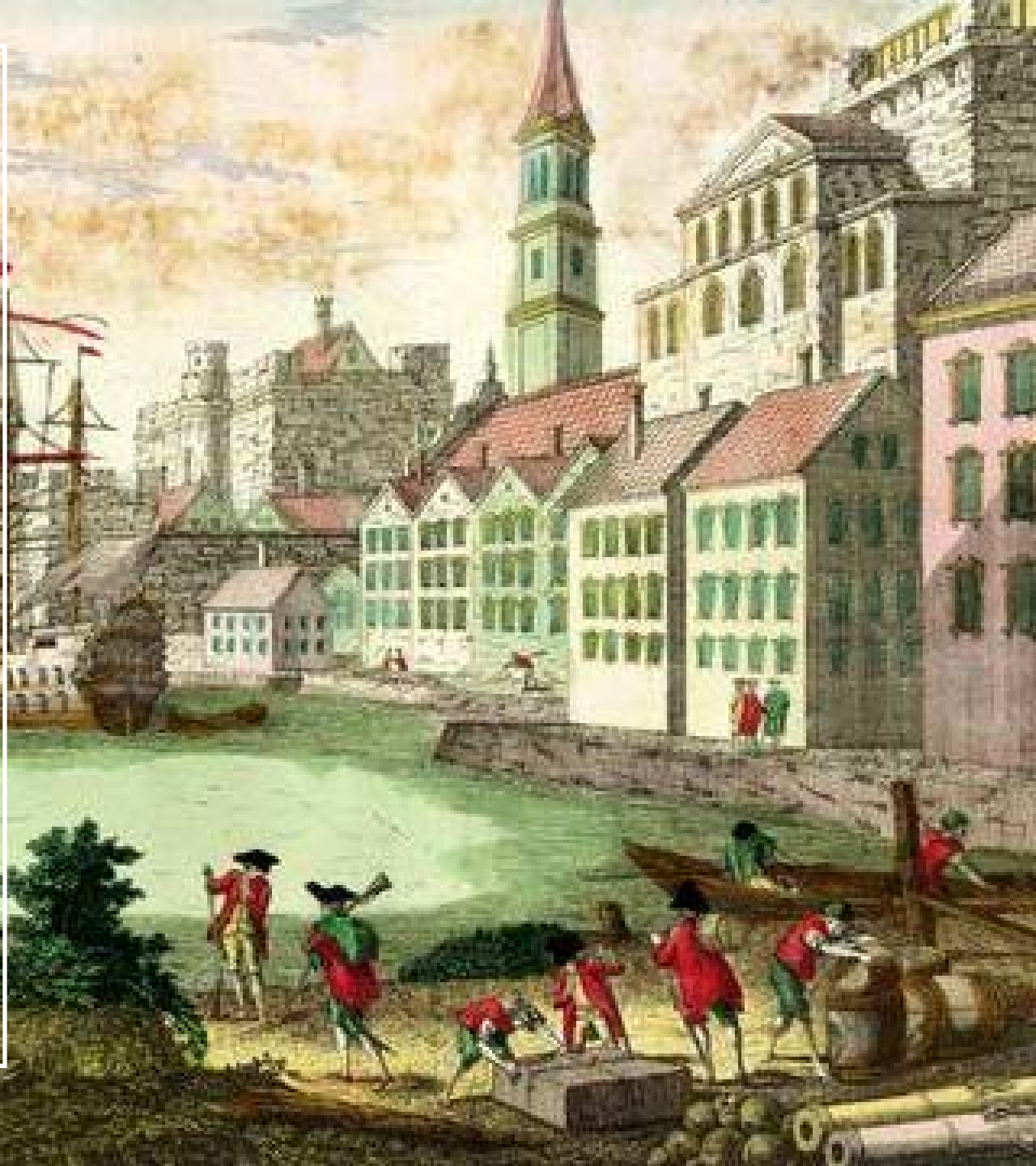
- Marriage
 - Native women had skills European traders did not have
 - Women's skills often saved fur traders (husbands)
- Marrying into tribe made trade easier (why)
- Tribes marrying trader meant that tribe traded only with the HBC.
- Traders sometimes had two families (one white, one native)
- Nature of trade led to cultural exchange which created a symbiotic relationship between French and Natives



Why Furs?

English Colonial Lifestyle

- English colonists brought pre-existing families to America
 - Often for religious reasons (effect on relationship)
- Established farms to support their community
- Built large coastal cities for trade with Europe
 - Limited interactions with natives
- Focused on cash crop production



Effect on Native life

French

- Incorporation
- Natives allowed to keep culture and feel like an equal partner in relationship.
- French used Native skills knowledge of the land to adapt to the environment.

English

- Forced Integration into European society
- Natives forced to adopt English lifestyle, religion
 - Native skills and knowledge lost
- English adapted environment to themselves
