Slavery Narrative Assessment

Write a narrative story from the perspective of a character who is captured and sold into slavery. Your writing will be from the 1st person which will serve as a way for you to demonstrate what you learned about the unit on slavery. Use what we have learned in class from lecture, discussion, images, readings and video as a base of knowledge.

Give your character an authentic voice by creating dialogue, have your character describe feelings and experiences, and even include details about the different elements of slavery that we learned about.

You must write about the topics of Africa, Middle Passage, Plantation Life, and Resistance. **The** requirement is that you include each topic in your narrative and that you include 3 main ideas that correspond with each topic.

- Africa
- Your name (directions will be given on how to create name, culture, and ethnic group)
- Where in Africa your character was from
- Ethnic group and basic culture traits such as language, agriculture, food, etc...
- Who captured you
- Transport to the coast
- Imprisonment in slave forts awaiting the Atlantic crossing
- The Middle Passage
 - The length of voyage
 - Meeting other people
 - Going to the ship
 - Conditions aboard the ship
 - punishment
 - The crew and captains treatment of the slaves
- In the Americas
 - Where in the Americas your character arrived
 - Auctions
 - Slave codes
 - Slave quarters
 - punishment
- Resistance
 - In your narrative you must include how your character resisted his or her treatment, or witnessed others resisting. This topic and ideas can be written about throughout the narrative, as it fits into your narrative.
 - On the slave ship
 - On the plantations and in the Americas
